**Apply for a visa now; do not wait.** Bring your CV with a list of publications and your registration confirmation to the visa interview. Purchasing flight tickets before applying for a visa does not speed up the application process, but presenting a confirmation is good evidence of intent to attend.

**Funding:** All ASHG participants are required to pay the registration fee and are individually responsible for all travel costs (this includes airfare, ground transportation, lodging, meals, travel insurance, and any other necessary expenses).
